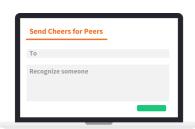
Building a great culture means recognizing when people contribute greatness to it.

Make recognition something everyone takes part in

Your leadership team aren't the only people who can recognize great work when they see it! Give employees a voice to recognize each other and celebrate all kinds of successes.

- Send a Cheers by typing in your message of appreciation, and put in the email address you'd like
 to send it to. They'll be notified that you sent them a Cheers via email.
- Choose if you want your recognition to be public or private. Public Cheers show up on the Cheers
 Feed, for everyone to see and celebrate.
- Integrate with slack, or set up our Cheers feed to stream directly to a screen in your office.

Send out gifts and rewards with one click

TINYgiftcards are a quick easy way to show your appreciation, while saving you from the time and logistics of your typical rewards program. Instead of going out to get prizes, send a TINYgiftcard, powered by TANGO card, that they can redeem in dozens of places, like Starbucks, Amazon, and Nordstrom.

- Assign permissions by department, by leadership level, or directly to individuals, on what amounts they
 can send to each other.
- Set a budget or a maximum amount per card, and load up your account with funds to distribute.
